The meeting came to order at 7:07 p.m.

Minutes: The July 6, 2010 minutes were reviewed. Randy moved to approve the minutes. Frank seconded. The minutes were approved as presented.

Cookeville Mall: Steve reported on the progress of the Mall: Randy installed a door where there once was a window and put up shelving. More shelving needs to be done as well as some electrical work. Steve suggested a grand opening on Saturday, August 14, 2010. Hours of operation would be Saturdays, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. (two shifts: 8 AM to 11 AM and 11 AM to 2 PM), staffed by volunteers. Linda suggested that a list of rules and hours be prominently posted. A list of "don't wants" was discussed and will include: clothing, footwear, tires, large electronics (computers, printers, TVs, etc.), stuffed furniture, magazines, plants. A bulletin board will be installed so people can advertise larger items. Linda will provide scrap paper (3" x 5") for people to use with the bulletin board. Earl has a piece of particle board approximately 2' x 3' to donate for the bulletin board. Shari will make paper signs to post at the Town Hall, Post Office, East Corinth General Store, Crossroads Trading Post and the Transfer Station. Steve will get the word out via the email list. Steve suggested we allow Thursday, August 12, and Friday, August 13, for us to drop items off as a "starter kit" for the August 14, 2010 grand opening. Shari will provide plastic grocery bags to the Mall.

Events: Linda has a call into Mark Green of VPR regarding a weather presentation. Shari will contact Vermont Fish & Game for programs they may offer, Frank suggested a presentation by the Vermont Coverts Group. Steve will make contact. Linda suggested a program on Invasive Exotic Species. Linda brought in three posters: one on mammals and two on birds. She will post the mammals poster on the Transfer Station bulletin board.

Trails: Roaring Ridge: Randy offered to construct the trail sign. He will contact Ginny and Anne to discuss. Clement Loop: Randy reported the kiosk map has been damaged

by condensation. Steve will contact Anne about getting a new map and having it laminated to prevent condensation damage in the future.

Next Meeting: The next meeting falls on Labor Day, September 6, 2010. Steve will contact Ginny about rescheduling.

Randy moved to adjourn the meeting. Steve seconded. The motion was unanimously approved. The meeting adjourned at 8:13 p.m.
