Steve suggested submitting Martha Rosten to the Select Board at their November 8, 2010 meeting with a request to appoint her to fill the vacancy.

Steve thanked Kelly McFarline for taking the minutes. We will discuss and designate a secretary to take minutes at a future meeting.

Events: Mike Scott Program on Winter Trees at the Roaring Ridge Trail: December 11, 2010 from 10:00 a.m. to noon. Mike Scott, a forester with RedStart, will lead a trail hike identifying winter trees. We need publicity, a poster, details need to go to Louise Sandberg for the Journal Opinion, approval to pay Mike. Steve will ask Anne Margolis

to take care of the publicity. Shari Tkac will contact Ginny Barlow about poster details. Frank Roderick moved to pay Mike Scott \$100 for his time. Penny Andrew seconded. Motion unanimously approved. Weather Program: Linda Tobin has calls into Mark Breen of VPR. Will follow up. Vermont Fish & Game "Bat" Presentation: Shari Tkac has scheduled Scott Darling for a January 21, 2011 presentation on a bat "white nose syndrome" to be held at the Corinth Town Hall. Sue Morse Wildlife Sampler Program: This program is a two-day event: 1) evening slideshow followed by 2) an outdoor workshop. Suggested dates: February 2 or February 3 for the slide show and February 5 for the outdoor workshop. Cost: \$900. Frank Roderick moved to spend \$900 for the 2-day event, subject to funds availability. Penny Andrew seconded. Motion unanimously approved.

Treasurer Report: Martha Rosten asked if a Treasurer's report is available. Steve Long said Anne Margolis is keeping track of the treasury and provides reports.

Town Forest Acquisition: Sue Shea has offered to gift a parcel of land to the Town of Corinth as a Town Forest. Ginny Barlow has applied for a grant, which if awarded, would completely fund the expenses involved in this acquisition. This would enable the Select Board to sign off on this with no financial expense to the town.

Cookeville Mall: a volunteer is needed to schedule staffing of the Mall. Steve suggested Louise Sandberg. He will ask Ginny Barlow to contact Louise.

Other Business: Steve summarized input for the Commission's report in the Town Report.

Penny Andrew moved to adjourn the meeting. Shari Tkac seconded. The motion was unanimously approved. The meeting adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
