Town Offices' up for re-election at Town Meeting March 1st 2011



Town Meeting may seem a long way off, but if you want to run for an office you need to fill out a nominating petition (you can pick one up here) return it to the Town Clerks Office along with a signed Consent of Candidate form by the close of the office (4:00 pm) January 24th. The Town Officer Positions up for re-election this coming March are as follows: Moderator for 1 year,

Selectman for 3 years, Lister for 3 years, Collector of Delinquent Taxes for 1 year, Town Clerk for 3 years, First Constable for 1 year, Second Constable for 1 year, Grand Juror for 1 year, Town Agent to Deed Real Estate for 1 year, Town Agent to Prosecute and Defend Suits 1 year Cemetery Commissioner 3 year, and Waits River Valley School Board of Directors 3 years.

BOND ISSUE UP FOR VOTE A SECOND TIME

In less than a year the Waits River Valley School Bond Issue will come up for the second time. The School Board has spent much time and many dollars making sure we get to vote on this again. The first vote was in March and the result of that vote was a very firm "No Thank-you". But the school board feels we need to rethink our position, so they lowered the bond from 7.3 million to 6.5 million and have given us another chance. (Approximate amount, quoted from a school board member, actual

amount to be announced) I have been told the vote this time is on Sat. Dec. 4th. The Corinth polls will be open in the Town Hall at 1387 Cookeville Rd. from 8:30 am until 7:00 pm.

There will also be a vote on the Corinth Zoning, Flooding and subdivision Bylaws sometime in the near future. So please come out to vote on these 3 very important issues, please cast your vote in all. Every vote counts toward the turn-out that you as a voter want.

Our collection of about 20,000 items continues to improve day by day, and those who have been into the library lately will tell you that whether you're five years old or ninety-five years old, and whether you're looking for classics or the latest titles, you're sure to find something you'll like on our shelves. But managing a quality collection is only part of what we do. Many folks know about the films we show on the big screen and the presentations and discussions we host, and many know that we provide computers and internet access. But many might not know that we are here to help you use the computers. Whether you're looking for a job or researching an obscure horse breed, we can help you. If you need to set up an e-mail account to connect with distant family members or conduct business, we can help you. And if you're curious about how to access benefits available from the Vermont Department of Children and Families, we can help with that, too. If you know of someone with a visual impairment who would like to find a way to connect with books, please let us know; for we can get large print and Braille books, and we can get audio book players specially designed for the visually impaired.

It's not for lack of work to do that we continue to look for new ways to serve the community. Between hosting programs, holding fundraisers, developing our collection, and circulating as many as 1,200 items a month, we keep on our toes. But we believe deeply in the notion that a library is a resource for the entire community, and we hope to continue to develop our capacity to serve all the people who call the Waits River Valley home. To that end, this winter we'll continue our fundraising efforts by holding a quilt raffle and sending out letters appealing for financial support. When you see raffle tickets for sale, and when you receive your letter in the mail, remember that the more support we receive, the more we can do for the community.

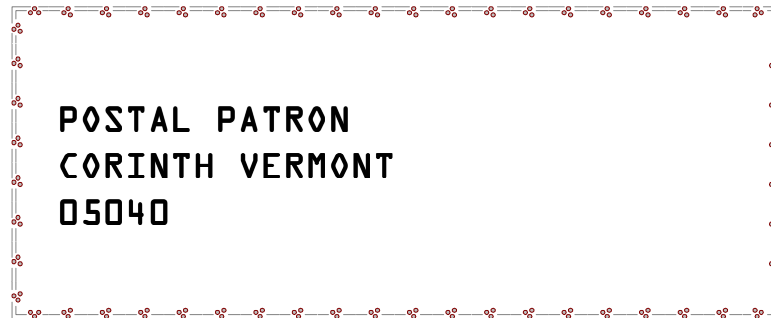
